A quick look at the need

- Right now in Collin County there are 750 homeless— 38% are children
- 80% of the students at Boyd Elementary live below the poverty level.
- The Ministerial Alliance food pantry provided food to more than 100 families last month, depleting their stock.
- Allen Community Outreach provided emergency food to 215 families, including 324 children.
- School children are about to be without free or reduced breakfast and lunches when the schools close for the holidays. Many will be home alone all day in the cold without a meal.
