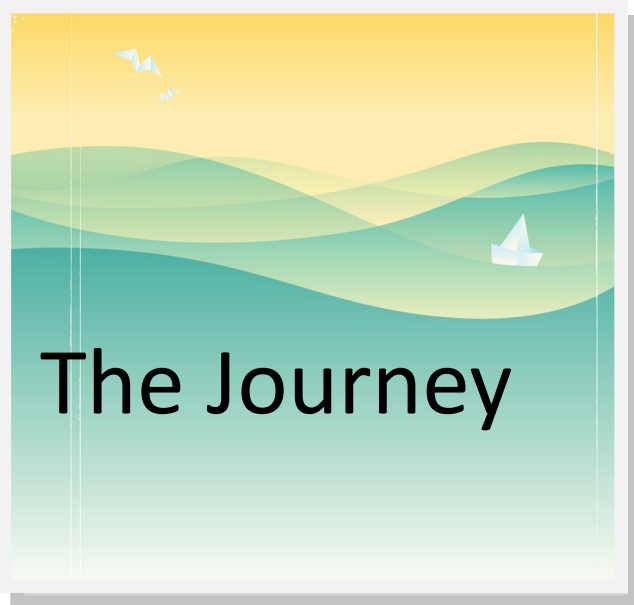
Suncreek Women's Retreat: Friday, March 23 - Sunday, March 25
